They say that a clear desk equals a clear mind – the same holds true for a clear database!

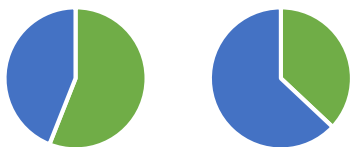
